(2511) Bus Service

Cllr Cockbill explained that there is no money available for more buses, they can however look into options for alternative times/routes. The '220' Saturday service will be removed in January. Cllr Cockbill sent all surveys that she received to ERYC, no response received as yet.

(2517) Sproatley Playing Fields

SPFA have received a grant of £10,000 from the Big Lottery Fund, they have also raised £3656.29 in the last two years. The equipment they have chosen is aimed at older children/teenagers, the total cost of this equipment is £13,678 which will leave them with a balance of £383.20.
