(2458) Rathlin Energy Liaison Committee

Recent brief update from Rathlin Energy (UK) Limited about the work taken place so far and next steps –

The rig mobilisation, current site layout and mobilisation of equipment is now almost completed. The current rig is smaller than the one used when WNA-1 was drilled. Rathlin Energy (UK) Limited company have drilled, cased and cemented the first section of the wellbore using the smaller conductor setting rig and are now mobilising and rigging up the equipment for the main drilling phase.

Once drilling has reached the bottom of the well, Rathlin Energy (UK) Limited will assess the data gathered during drilling to decide if the well warrants testing. The aim of any future testing is to establish the quality of gas, volume present and rate that it can be produced at, which will help determine whether the project is likely to be commercially viable.

The ground under the zip wire has now been raised higher and complies with safety regulations.

Cllr Cochran advised that the fire brigade were called to a fire in the woodland, damage has been caused to the base of a tree and two litter bins were also damaged. Burton Constable Estate who own the land have been informed and a police log number issued.
