Clerk provided copies of the last 4 invoices from the Syndicate of Horticulture which totalled £2719.62. ERYC had contacted to advise to reduce costs the salt bins will not receive a maintenance visit prior to the start of the season and these should be carried out be the Parish Council and any issues reported to ERYC.

It had been brought to the attention of Cllr Smales that there was a tree stump on The Green. Cllr's agreed that this should be removed and Cllr Smales will arrange for this to be done.

Cllr's discussed buying a gift for Cllr's Buck & Wright and it was agreed to put together a hamper for Harry spending £200 plus a book on the East Riding. To discuss a gift for Cllr Wright at the next meeting. All in favour- Cllr Smales will arrange this.
